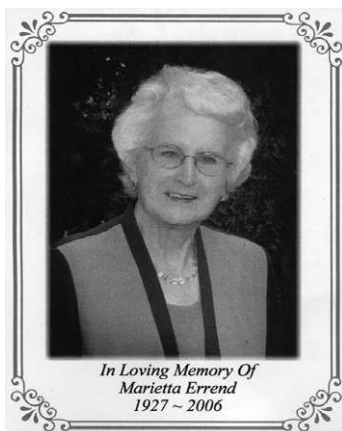
He was preceded in death by his sister, Ann O'Neill.
