Arizona fugitive caught in Vernonia

Officers from the Vernonia Police Department arrested a fugitive, from Arizona, near Bridge St. and Adams Ave. on July 25 after being contacted by the Arizona Department of Public Safety Fugitive Apprehension Task Force.

The suspect, Heath Michael Jacobs (also known as Michael Zimmerman), age 23, was taken into custody without incident on four felony charges out of Arizona: Absconded Sexual Offender; Sexual Assault of a Minor; Failure to Appear (Driving Under the Influence); Resisting Arrest/Assault. According to the Task Force, Jacobs was reportedly living and working in Vernonia under the name Michael Zimmerman, and was possibly dating a girl named "Shannon".

Vernonia police officers were familiar with "Michael Zimmerman" and were able to locate him at corner of Bridge St. and Adams Ave. at approximately 4:00 p.m. in the business,

"Pretty Gifts and Things". Jacobs was taken into custody without incident. Also at the location was Shannon Fennern, age 18, of Vernonia. Fennern was questioned and subse-

quently issued a citation for Hindering Prosecution.

Jacobs is in the Columbia County Jail while awaiting extradition back to Maricopa County, Arizona.

our state. The northwest corner of our state is a natural place for these parks because of the close location of major populations. While in the lower Nehalem River valley, I have often thought that there is a unique opportunity for the state to make a sort of linear camping area along the river. Currently, there are wide spots along the lower Nehalem County road that get very heavy usage, but it is unmanaged usage that brings litter, human waste and rowdy behavior. If these areas were developed into managed primitive

camp areas, with adequate waste facilities and usage fees, then they could be properly managed and patrolled to avoid the current problems. It is often this unmanaged rowdy behavior that the local residents most object to. I don't blame the locals for that objection, but the solution is to manage the problem, not duck our heads, ignore it and hope the problem goes away.

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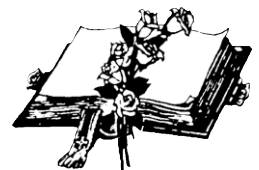
