Expect delays on Cornelius Pass

Road construction will limit traffic to one lane in each direction on Cornelius Pass Road between Jacobson Road and Rock Creek Boulevard, from August 24 through 28.

According to Washington County's Department of Land Use and Transportation the restriction is planned for the time when the county's contractor, Baker Rock, will be grinding and reconstructing the road.

The county and Baker Rock

are working together to ensure that traffic moves as smoothly as possible through this necessary, though inconvenient, road work. About 10,000 vehicles a day travel south on Cornelius Pass Road at this location, according to 2006 traffic counts.
