school reconstruction, to replace school equipment and supplies lost in the flood, for the city to repair and replace assets, and to help with the repair or replacement of the city's water and wastewater treatment systems. These requests will have to go through the regular Congressional appropriations process.

Wu concluded with special words for the seniors, wishing them well as they begin the next phase of their life and that he hopes they go to a community college or university. He went on to say that statistics indicate that people with four year degrees will make an average of \$1 million more during their lives than those who don't, and will have a better chance of answering those life questions for themselves.
