gion, organized in 1919, was responsible for the creation of the original GI Bill, and instru-

mental in the passage of legislation creating the Department of Veterans Affairs. More than 25,000 Legionnaires across

Oregon, plus 10,000 members of the Sons of the American Legion and the American Legion Auxiliary, collectively volunteer thousands of hours to assist our veterans and their communities. Mayor Kinsky signed the proclamation and encouraged citizens to celebrate the many contributions made by members of the American Legion.

The city's contract planner, KJ Won, told Council that the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) is requesting Banks to extend its current population projection by four years. Won explained optional procedures for the revision and council approved the method he recommended. Council also approved having Hough and Won negotiate with the county to come up with the best projection for the city.

The next city council meeting will be held in city hall on March 10 at 7:30 p.m.
