will assess the effectiveness of current transit services and facilities. Draft recommendations for the two projects have been identified and will be described at the upcoming meetings.

The Transit Plan Update builds on the Columbia County Community-wide Transit Plan, adopted in 2002, and the Coordinated Transit Services Plan, completed in 2007. The updat-

ed Transit Plan will provide further direction for the planning and implementation of transit services, operations, facilities, funding, and promotion/information efforts for the next 10

In concert with the Transit Plan update, Columbia County is developing a Transit Access Management Plan for US 30. This project will identify improvements for pedestrian and

bicycle access to transit on the US 30 corridor, develop designs for urban and rural bus stops/pullouts, and create a program for park-and-ride or park-and-pool lots. Recommended improvements within the corridor will build on, and will be consistent with, the existing and recommended future transit system that is identified in Transit Plan.

Recommendations from these projects will be presented at the meetings, along with a variety of opportunities to comment on them.
