Witt bills would harm our property rights

To the Editor:

Our state Representative, Brad Witt, has been busy telling us all the wonderful things he's doing for us in Salem through newspaper columns newsletters. Unfortunately, he's neglected to mention two bills

he's sponsored that will have a profound negative effect on our property rights and lifestyles.

One is HB3058, sponsored by Witt and one other representative. This bill would allow corporations to get wetland fill permits on private property they don't own, and get permits for work on private property even when the landowner opposes the permit. The landowner doesn't even have to be notified that the permit has been applied for.

Coupled with a corporation's legal right to use eminent domain to force the sale of private property, it means any of us could end up with, for instance, an LNG (Liquid Natural Gas) pipeline going through what was formerly our land. Witt is a big supporter of the proposed LNG terminal on the Columbia and the 600 miles of pipeline needed by it and other pro-


