responsibilities are to renew applications with ODOT, Verizon, and PGE; renew certificate of liability; monitor the condition of the pennants, take down and put up brackets as needed, and approve/disapprove of potential new pennant design applications within permit requirements. Ford commented that the program has been "pretty good up 'til now; we want to make it better" with clear rules of responsibilities.

Council approved a \$15,539 contract with Griffith Roofing, Co. for replacement of the roof on the City Hall building complex. They also directed city staff to continue application for FEMA disaster relief funds to reimburse the roof repair costs.

A contract for replacement of City Hall windows went to Five-Star Builders, Inc., in the amount of \$16,550. This is included in the recently adopted Banks Capital Improvement Plan, which provides for continued upgrade of City Hall's energy efficiency and improvement of the condition of the building.
