sober moment when the end of a hunt is reached and I have taken a life. The buck that lay before me was a magnificent animal; I had made a good stalk and a clean kill. But I also knew that it might be 13 years, again, before I would get to experience this great high desert country and the inspiring antelope bucks that run across its horizons. I also realized it may very well be my last antelope hunting trip with my father.

Speaking of Dad, he was soon on the radio, then drove down into the bottom, packed up the pack boards and took some pictures of my prize and me. Even at 82, he packed the

head and some of my gear down the hill to the waiting pickup. Boy, I sure hope I'm still doing that when I reach those years in my life.
