Vernonia Eye Clinic offers eve exams and has a dispensary with a good selection of frames at the office to fit everyone from infants up. Glasses take about a week to arrive, and contacts are available in the office or within 2-3 days.

Dr. Masalmeh can also handle about 80-90% of eye infections, eye diseases and eye injuries, and can refer to an ophthalmologist for those that can't be handled here. "When I came here I really wanted to offer full service," Masalmeh stated.

Masalmeh wants to expand his selection of frames even further, and get more equipment to meet his stated goal, "My ultimate mission is to give good service to the community and make sure people's eyes are healthy, and people don't have to travel so far."
