## Council adopts 1997 strategic plan without any recommended modifications

At the May 17 Vernonia City Council meeting, an item that was added to the agenda at the beginning of the meeting caused the most discussion.

A document given to council did not indicate who wrote it, but was read by councilor Kevin Hudson (see related article on page 1). The document suggested a motion that said, "I move that Council direct the City Administrator to investigate an intergovernmental agreement with another city for the purpose of establishing a partnership in a municipal court system, and to present the resulting options and make a recommendation at the next Council meeting on June 7, 2010." The supporting data stated that Vernonia police are not getting a "satisfactory level" of service from the Justice Court. Council unanimously approved the motion.

Council unanimously ap-

proved the second reading of Ordinance 866, which officially adopts the city's 1997 strategic plan without any of the modifications recommended from the process held early this spring with consultant Paul Koch. Council members discussed wanting to adopt the plan, then get committee, commission and community input on possible modifications. No time frame was set for that process.

After holding an executive session (closed to the public) to discuss real estate negotiations, council returned to the regular meeting and made the statement that they "...need an evaluation of where utilities are to determine, in an expedient manner, how much property we need or want to buy, and check with the engineers on how the road got built and determine any reason we might want to buy all this property."

Council approved a list of

nine more flood buy-outs (to be demolished) presented by Dan Brown from the Unmet Needs Committee.

City staff, Joann Glass and Public Works Director Bob Ruhl, asked council to allow them to redraft the utility ordinances and evaluate the associated fees. The evaluation will include consideration of making property owners responsible for water payments, rather than renters. Council gave them the go-ahead on this request.

Representatives from the Vernonia Ridge Riders asked for city help with problems at the arena, including a need for gravel, a broken water shut-off valve cover and an increasingly large sink hole. City attorney Jeff Bennett advised the city to send a public works person down to the site, the following day, to take care of any safety concerns before the next arena event to be held this weekend. In other business, the council: • heard from the Mayor that

the Vernonia Lions Club will celebrate the grand opening of the temporary wheels park, at the old tennis court on school grounds, on the 4th of July. Volunteers and donors can contact Larry Snethen at 503-819-5636 to help with the project.

• heard from Chief of Police Frank Grace that one of the officers (Jeff Dalrymple) resigned on May 11, and that the department will begin the process of hiring a replacement.

straint use is the number one way to prevent injury or death if you or your children are involved in a crash.

Oregon law requires:

 Infants to ride in rear facing seats until they are one year old and 20 pounds.

· Children over one year old between 20 and 40 pounds must be in a forward facing car seat.

Children who weigh over
40 pounds must be properly
secured in a booster seat until
they are 8 years old or 4'9" tall.
Children who are over 8

years old or 4'9" and all adults must be properly secured using seat belts.

• NHTSA recommends that all children under 12 years old ride in the back seat. Research indicates that riding in the rear seating area reduces the risk of injury by 37% for that age group.
