

# Members sought for county boards

The following boards are currently seeking applications for new members:

- Cultural Coalition of Washington County (CCWC). CCWC administers distribution of any state funds received by Washington County from the Community Cultural Participation Grant Program of the Oregon Cultural Trust. The CCWC distributes funds through a competitive process to Washington County-based organizations and artists to address priorities identified in the Washington County Cultural Plan. Members may serve a maximum of two (2) consecutive terms only. There is a time commitment of 6-8 meetings per year for this three year position.

- Public Safety Coordinating Council (PSCC) – At Large and

At Large (Minority). Council members coordinate local criminal justice and juvenile justice policy and make recommendations for the use of state resources for public safety purposes. There are Twenty-five members including the presiding Circuit Court Judge, various elected officials from the County and cities, state and local law enforcement, the County Administrator and other County managers, lay citizens representing each Commissioner's district, and lay citizens representing minorities (at-large appointment). This two year term position is expected to have a time commitment of four hours or less per month.

- Homeless Plan Advisory Committee (HPAC) seeks a mayor or city councilor; faith

community member; sheriff's office; a nonprofit service provider and a citizen at-large member. All will serve three year terms.

The Committee will be advisory to the county Homeless Program Coordinator, the Director of Housing Services, the County Administrator, and the Board of County Commissioners.

## Evers pleads guilty before trial

Dale Joseph Evers, 42, Banks, was scheduled to start a new trial November 2, after a jury deadlocked in August on seven charges relating to inappropriate acts with minor females. Instead, Evers entered a guilty plea on October 22 to several attempted sex abuse and perjury charges. He is expected to be sentenced to between three and four years of prison on these charges.

Evers had been found not guilty of six other counts, though he was convicted of

three counts of supplying alcohol to minors, at his August trial.

The perjury charge stemmed from statements he made in the August trial that were later proven to be false.
