Old and new Vernonia council members and mayor change places

The Vernonia City Council that met on December 20 had a very different make-up than the one that met on January 3. Outgoing members Mayor Sally Harrison, Councilor Cindy Ball Councilor Catherine and Helmer all received certificates of appreciation for their service, at their final meeting. Incoming Mayor Josette Mitchell, and new councilors Willow Burch and Marilyn Nicks, all took oaths of office at their first seating on January 3.

An amendment to extend Bill Haack's contract as Pro Tem City Administrator to June 30, 2011, was discussed and approved at both meetings. At the December meeting, the outgoing council voted to approve the amendment but for a few minutes it looked iffy. When Harrison asked for a motion there was silence. On her second request of, "Do I hear a motion," Councilor Randy Parrow made the motion which was then seconded and carried. On January 3, the incoming council voted to approve (with Councilor Marilyn Nicks abstaining without explanation) the amendment. The new council had to ratify the amendment because of a provision that an outgoing council cannot bind a contract for an incoming

In December Council heard an update from Ben Fousek on the city's GIS project. Fousek reported that there is a possibility that FEMA may use the city's GIS for flood mapping, and that might lower the flood insurance rates by 20 percent.

Councilor Kevin Hudson asked Haack to provide an update on the contract for the police department's K9 officer, at the next meeting.

Haack told council he will be working with the city's financial director to find funds for some council training and the hiring process for a new City Administrator. More information will be provided at the next council meeting.

In other business, council:

- · Approved the procedure outlined by the Public Works Committee to move towards hiring someone to do a rate study of water, sewer and system development charges.

- · Okayed a resolution to transfer funds within the Airport fund to allow the purchase of gravel for the road to Airport

· Heard from Interim Chief of Police Mike Conner that New Year's Eve was uneventful; the only activity was a couple of traffic stops.

The next meeting will be Tuesday, January 18 (due to a holiday on Jan. 17) at City Hall, and will start with a work session at 6:00 p.m. before the regular 7:00 p.m. meeting.

Utility rate studies needed to help assure timely loan repayments

The City of Vernonia Public Works Committee, the City Engineer, and the Interim City Administrator have worked together the past few months to look closely at current utility rates and weigh the need for modification of the rate structure.

Prior to the 2007 flood, the Vernonia City Council and former City Administrator Dick Kline, formed the Vernonia Public Works Committee. It was anticipated at that time that the Public Works Committee would make regular reports to the public about the City's public works systems and the utility rates that pay for them. It is hoped that these reports can provide the public with some of the complex information that the engineers and the City Council must digest before making decisions that impact utility rates.

From the beginning, the sewer project has been the 800 pound gorilla in the room. For most of the last two decades Vernonia has been under an enforcement order from Ore-
