Microsoft's website states, "We do not send unsolicited email or make unsolicited phone calls to request personal or financial information or fix your computer."

Warning: Be wary of unsolicited calls.

· Confirm the problem: Never give personal or financial information to an unsolicited caller. If they claim to be from a specific entity, contact them usout if there is a real issue. Don't download attachments or trust e-mail links.

- Don't agree to purchase over the phone: Ask for information in writing. Read the details and research the offer. If you still want to purchase, credit cards tend to have more protections than debit cards.
- Report fraudulent activity: Complaints can be filed with the Federal Trade Commission

She was preceded in death by her brother.


