## OSU announces 4-H scholarships opportunities

OSU Extension Service in Columbia County has announced their \$5,000 scholarship for 4-H youth attending Oregon State University in the fall.

The Columbia County 4-H Finance & Investment Scholarship is designed for youth who are interested in pursuing a degree at Oregon State University. This is a multi-year scholarship, of up to \$1,250 per year, for four years at OSU. Scholarship recipients must be attending Oregon State University and be majoring in Finance or a closely related field in either the College of Business or the Agricultural and Resource Economics Program.

We met with the building inspectors and city planner last week to make sure we get everything in order to proceed. We began pouring concrete at the new school site this week!


Meanwhile, back at the district...we have a budget to prepare for next year.

We are facing some cuts, though not as many as we thought we faced last December. The current K-12 budget forecast is for \$5.6 billion, which translates to needing to cut approximately \$433,000 from our current budget. To do this we have begun holding Budget Assistance Team

(BAT) meetings involving administrators, staff, and community members from the district budget committee to discuss our options.

We need your help! The decisions we will be making will impact the education of our children. You can be part of this process!

Officially there are only three meetings that a budget committee member needs to attend: a budget committee meeting held as part of the May school board meeting (May 12), a second meeting to review the budget in detail (May 26 for about 90 minutes), and the last being the June
