Columbia County to Hold CPAC Elections

Columbia County will be holding Citizen Planning Advisory Committee (CPAC) election, for

those positions whose term is expiring.

CPACs provide advice and recommendations to the County Land Use Planning entities, including the Planning Department, the Planning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners. CPAC members serve for two-year terms.

Each CPAC is divided into neighborhoods. Members represent neighborhoods in which they reside or own property. Resident and/or property owners within the neighborhoods elect their CPAC members. There must be at least five voters from each neighborhood to hold an election for the

neighborhood. In order to be eligible to vote you must show either picture identification proving that you live in the CPAC neighborhood where you will cast your ballot; or a tax statement proving you own property within the neighborhood where you are voting. You may only vote once in your CPAC area.

The CPAC elections will be held in the following locations, and at the following times:

Mist-Birkenfeld, Tuesday, May 17, 2011 at 7:00 p.m., Natal Grange.

Scappoose-Spitzenberg, May 10, 2011, at 6:30 p.m., Scappoose Library.
