SUN DRIED TOMATO SALAD DRESSING

1/2 cup sun-dried tomatoes, drained, or rehydrated if dry
 2/3 cup olive oil
 2 T fresh basil
 2 tsp capers
 2 cloves garlic
 2 T balsamic vinegar
 salt and black pepper to taste

Process all ingredients in a blender or food processor until smooth. Add more liquid if needed. Serves 4.

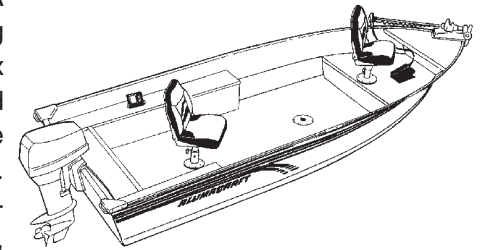

hundred to over 1,000 pounds of water. Emptying tanks also slows the spread of invasive species.

• **Slow down:** A decrease in towing speed of just five or six miles-per-hour can lead to a noticeable decrease in fuel consumption. Trailer tires have a maximum speed of 65 mph,

so going over that will not only harm MPG, but could damage tires as well.

• **Go local:** Plan more trips closer to home this summer.
