The plan, passed in the 2011 Legislative Session as House Resolution 3, directs the Oregon Seismic Safety Policy Advisory Commission (OSS-PAC) to make recommenda-

tions on policy direction to protect lives and keep commerce flowing in the event of a major earthquake.

"I would like to thank the fine people at OSSPAC, as well as community members Jay Raskin and Edward Wolf, for their hard work in helping House Resolution 3 become reality," said Rep. Boone, "All Oregonians need to be aware of the importance of emergency preparedness. Being prepared for an emergency will save lives and put the region on track for a better recovery."

The plan is will be delivered to the Legislature no later than February 28, 2013.
