He enjoyed woodworking and taught himself how to build cabinets, hutches, tables, lawn furniture, shelves and many other items. He enjoyed sharing home improvement and landscape projects with his wife. He also spent time reading, going to the gym, taking family trips, and checking out classic/hot rod vehicle shows.


He was preceded in death by his mother and father.
