The Journal is just in its criticism; but what it fails to say is that it is just this fact that an attempt is being made to separate Church and State that distresses the Catholic Church. A loyal Catholic is bound by the basic inflexib'e constitution of the Papacy, and the fundamental Canon Law of his Church, to resist such separation. He can have no genuine "patriotism" toward a government "by the people." The Catholic Church is an uncompromising enemy of any system based upon "liberty of conscience." The loyal Catholic, who is intelligent, gives assent to free institutions only from "motives of expediency," and only until such time as the Church feels strong enough to strike them down.

The Journal's statement that the anti-Catholic feeling is "without reason" is, in part, contradicted by its own criticism of that old political buccaneer.
