

PAPAL NOTES

"Tumulty has completely enveloped Wilson," they say in Washington.

"I do not pretend to be a prophet. But though not a prophet, I see a very dark cloud on our horizon. That dark cloud is coming from Rome. It is filled with tears of blood. After it is over, there will be long days of peace and prosperity; for popery, with its Jesuits and merciless Inquisition, will have been forever swept away from our country. The Knights of Columbus order is nothing but the recruiting, drilling army of the old enemy from whom our fathers fled when they left Europe. Read it:

A Bill to Amend the Postal Laws

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That whenever it shall be established to the satisfaction of the Postmaster-General that any person is engaged in the business of publishing any scandalous, scurrilous, indecent or immoral books, pamphlets, pictures, prints, engravings, lithographs, photographs or other publications which are, or are represented to be, a reflection on any form of religious worship practiced or held sacred by any citizens of the United States, it is hereby declared that the Postmaster-General shall make the necessary rules and regulations to exclude such matter from the mails.

Read it again! Could anything be worse and engage the attention of our law makers for one moment? What does the United States Constitution say? Here it is, read it:

"Congress shall make no laws respecting an establishment of religion, or of prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances."

Read it again! If the bill above mentioned, which has already been introduced, passes, no one can print anything and send it to his friends, unless he has the consent of one man. This is "one man rule" with a vengeance; and it is coming and will keep coming unless we put the enemy forever out of business.

Is it true, or not true, that the Roman Catholic Hierarchy (and the ideas which this powerful organization promulgates) is responsible for the conditions in Europe? Is it true or not true that she is responsible for the situation in Mexico? Did this enemy of democracy and freedom

cause the Civil War and kill Lincoln? Let this great immortal prophet speak again as to the cause of the Civil War:

"It is with the southern leaders of this Civil War, as with the big and small wheels of our railroad cars. Those who ignore the laws of mechanics are apt to think that the large, strong and noisy wheels that they see, are the motive power, but they are mistaken. The real motive power is not seen; it is noiseless and well concealed in the dark, behind its iron walls. The motive power are the few well concealed pails of water heated into steam, which is itself directed by the noiseless, small, but unerring engineer's finger.

"The common people see and hear the big, noisy wheels of the Southern Confederacy's cars, they call them Jeff Davis, Lee, Toombs, Beauregard, Semmes, etc., and they honestly think that they are the motive power, the first cause of our troubles. But it is a mistake. The true motive power is secreted behind the thick walls of the Vatican, the colleges and schools of Jesuits, the convents of the nuns and the confessional boxes of Rome.

"There is a fact which is too much ignored by the American people, and with which I am acquainted only since I became President; it is that the best, the leading families of the South, have received their education in great part, if not in whole, from the Jesuits and the nuns. Hence those degrading principles of slavery, pride, cruelty, which are as a second nature among so many of those people. Hence that strange want of fair play, humanity; that implacable hatred against the ideas of equality and liberty, as we find them in the Gospel of Christ. You do not ignore that the first settlers of Louisiana, Florida, New Mexico, Texas, South California and Missouri, were Roman Catholics, and that their first teachers were Jesuits. It is true that

those states have been conquered or bought by us since. But Rome had put the deadly virus of her anti-social and anti-Christian maxims into the veins of the people before they became American citizens. Unfortunately the Jesuits and the nuns have in great part remained the teachers of those people since. They have continued, in a silent, but most efficacious way, to spread their hatred against our institutions, our laws, our schools, our rights and liberties, in such a way, that this terrible conflict became unavoidable, between the North and the South. As I told you before, it is to Popery that we owe this terrible civil war.

"I would have laughed at the man who would have told me that before I became the President. But Professor Morse has opened my eyes on that subject. And, now, I see that mystery; I understand that engineering of hell which, though not seen, nor even suspected by the country, is putting in motion the large, heavy and noisy wheels of the state cars of the Southern Confederacy."

And now we are driving ahead into another great conflict with this enemy of liberty, purity and progress; and those who think, will see beyond Woodrow Wilson, Tumulty, Roosevelt, Taft, Madera, Bryan, Carranza, Villa and the Supreme Court, right behind the thick walls of the Vatican, and right behind the thick walls of the little Vatican's scattered like great sores all over this glorious republic.

The Christianity of History

A Romanist priest, George Thompson of Portland, in a recent letter to the "Telegram" so strikingly illustrates the methods and the spirit of Romanism, that it would be a pity not to notice him. He says "Historical evidence proves to a demonstration that the Christianity of History, whatever else it may have been, was not the religion of Protestants." He refers to Cardinal Newman, who said substantially the same thing. In its substance, the same remark is frequently made by Romanists. It is a catchy statement and to the uninformed it seems very profound and very comprehensive and some may think that Protestantism has no support from history; but the statement is superficial and lacking in candor. When the priest names "The Christianity of History," he would exclude from notice the Greek and Oriental Churches, as well as the small bodies of dissenters who, at various times and places, sought to learn and practice the Teachings of the Bible, but who, whenever found, were persecuted to the death by the priests of Rome. These priests and the civil rulers they could control, never tolerated dissent. They would have you believe that Romanism is the "Christianity of History," whole and entire; and Thompson has done us a special kindness, and has earned our lasting gratitude in proving "with a wig full of learning" that the "Religion of Protestants" is not such counterfeit of Christianity as that practiced by Rome during the ages past.

But is it true that Romanism is "The Christianity of History?" If it were, God pity both the "History" and the "Christianity." Let us consider the facts. Christianity was preached in Rome and a church formed in the days of the Apostles. Pastors were provided, and the chief pastor was named "bishop." The churches at other cities in the empire respected the chief pastor of the Roman Church, according to the character he exhibited, and as pastor of the church in the capital city of the empire. The Greek and the Oriental churches never did more than this — they never confessed him as their master.

As time passed, as persecution from the pagans ceased, and as the church in Rome became stronger, ambitious men sought the office of bishop and strove to gain wider authority. Thus, after some centuries of struggle the bishops of Rome, who now took the name Pope, became rulers of the churches of western Europe. Thence forward, until the sixteenth century, no form of worship other than the Roman, was publicly recognized.

What did the bishops of Rome, now calling themselves popes, do for the religious life of themselves and their people? They had built the clergy into a singularly powerful organization. By craft they had gained control of the minds and consciences of the ignorant, and they maintained authority by persecuting, and as far as possible, destroying all who dared think, or believe, or worship differently from themselves. The only form of religious worship to which, from the seventh to the sixteenth century, Europeans had free access, was the form prescribed by Rome. Here and there were persons who, born as Romanists, had learned something better, but seeking to practice it, Rome persecuted them to the death. The "History" of those times tells little about these people, but thank God, the "Religion of Protestants" is entirely different from the pretended "Christianity" of Rome, as practiced during these ages and since. Now let Cardinal Baronius tell what that "Christianity" was about the Tenth Century. He says:

"Oh, what was then the face of the holy Roman church, how filthy, when the vilest and most powerful prostitutes ruled in the court of Rome, by whose arbitrary sway dioceses were made and unmade, bishops were consecrated and, which is inexpressibly horrible to be mentioned, false popes, their paramours, were thrust into the chair of St. Peter, who, in being numbered as popes, serve no purpose, except to fill up the catalogues of the popes of Rome. For who can say that persons thrust into the papedom, without any law, by harlots of this sort, were legitimate popes of Rome? In this manner, lust, supported by secular power, excited to frenzy in the rage for domination, ruled in all things."
