If the pugnacious pigs who are so busily wagging their jaws these days and spoiling for a fight, with each other were to enlist in the army and go and fight Spain instead, it would be an immeasurable relief to the country—even though they all got killed.

Now that peace negotiations have been opened, there will of course be great diversity of opinions as to what the terms ought to be, and the man who makes it his business in life to "cuss" the government will be much in evidence.

President McKinley's prudence in not recognizing the in-urgent government in Cuba is now admitted almost unanimously. The insurgents have yet to prove their fitness to be at the head of a new republic, created by the arms of the United States.

It is a gratifying fact that at least one of Cervera's disabled war vessels is in a fair way to be raised and restored by the United States. The Maria Teresa repaired, rechristened and manned by American seamen may win the victories to which by her excellent construction, she is entitled.

It is to be hoped that in the final arrangement of peace between this country and the United States the Philippines may not be once more turned over to Spain, which has for so long been their oppressor and spoiler. The island of Luzon might well be retained permanently by the United States as a partial indemnity for the expense of the war.

Aguinaldo, the Philippine insurgent chief, since the Americans have come to his aid and whipped the Spaniards soundly, seems to have taken to himself all the glory of the victory and now begins to assume authority and threatens his benefactors. The administration has not yet concluded permanently to retain the Philippines, and if Aguinaldo and his ungrateful countrymen should be turned over once more to the Spaniards they will probably make short work of him.

From indications, at the hour of going to press, it appears that the war is about over. If Spain has a particle of common sense and sound judgment left she will see that the terms offered by this country, are unusually generous. The independence of Cuba is, of course, a foregone conclusion, and the United States benefits little by it.

People who feel disposed to find fault with the administration at Washington for its apparent willingness in the interests of peace, to surrender all of the Philippines except an island for a coal station will do well to consider for a moment the cost of this government should we conclude to retain them. Commodore Dewey informs us that there is little doubt but that we should have to whip the insurgents as well as the Spaniards, and he estimates that it would require at least 150,000 soldiers to do it. In addition to this, foreign complications are not at all improbable and a war with Germany, France or Russia, or all combined would be within the range of possibilities.

In the summer of 1894 the present writer, while crossing the continent, was delayed four times between San Francisco and Chicago by the various "labor armies" seizing and stopping trains ahead of him. At that time these armies were commanded by one Coxey, one Debs, and there were various Fryes, Kelleys, and other local demagogues whose names we do not remember.

These so-called "armies" were crawling like army-worms across the country toward Washington. They preserved a semblance of military organization, and there were generals, colonels, and captains among them. These circumstances are now recalled to us by the fact that we hear nothing of any of these "labor armies" now that we have war upon us.

It is to be hoped that in the final arrangement of peace between this country and the United States the Philippines may not be once more turned over to Spain, which has for so long been their oppressor and spoiler. The island of Luzon might well be retained permanently by the United States as a partial indemnity for the expense of the war.

These peace negotiations will be satisfactory in the end if the government has the determination to carry out its announced decision of allowing no parley, but only action. Accept our terms or fight, is the ultimatum, and all that needs to be done is to insist upon it. Spain will hesitate and palaver—we shall go on and occupy the Philippines. Cuba and Porto Rico we are sure of. Every day's added expense will only increase our claims at Manila.—Or.
