BRANTON EXECUTED.

EUGENE, Or., May 12.—Claude Branton, who, with Courtland Green, murdered John A. Linn, a Gilliam county stockman, in the foothills of Eastern Lane county, last June, was hanged at 10:50 this morning.

At 9:30 his relatives were admitted to the jail, and conversed with him a few moments. Sheriff Withers then read the warrant.

Branton left the cell at 10:45 under the charge of the sheriff and two deputies. He walked upon the scaffold unassisted and took his place on the trap.

In a firm voice he told those present that he did not want them to bear any ill-will against his people on his account. He asked for sympathy and prayers, and urged them to walk in God's way.

Before leaving the cell Branton bid good-bye to all around. He was perfectly calm.

Branton left several letters to be mailed, and gave a white tie to his brother and left a Bible to his mother. All was done without a quiver of a muscle.

About 60 people witnessed the execution, while a thousand or more stood in the street around the inclosure, but were quiet and orderly.
