County Court Proceedings.

County Court convened in regular session Wednesday, March 5th, 1902, with G. W. Sappington, County Judge; L. Parrish, Commissioner; Homer Mason, Clerk; and H. H. Alderman, Sheriff, present, when the following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the resignation of Arthur Hunt as supervisor of road district No. 6: Resignation accepted and J. H. Mapes appointed to fill said vacancy.

In the matter of the petition of T. J. Harris, et al., for a county road. Continued for further proceedings.

In the matter of the petition of P. D. Newell, et al., to build a bridge across the South Fork of the Nehalem river. Continued for further proceedings.

In the matter of the petition of A. J. Rhoades, et al., for a bridge across the Nestaca river. Continued.

In the matter of the report of P. H. M. Smith, as supervisor of road district No. 1. Approved.

In the matter of the report of G. W. Wallace, as supervisor of road district No. 12. Approved.

In the matter of the report of W. C. Wolfe, as supervisor of road district No. 13. Approved.

In the matter of the report of G. W. Boddyfelt, as supervisor of road district No. 14. Approved.

In the matter of the petition for the establishment of a county high school. It was ordered that said question be submitted to the qualified electors and that the county clerk, in connection with and at the time of the notice of the general election to be held in June, 1902, make provision for voting upon said question upon the official ballot in the manner provided by law.

In the matter of the petition of the Common Council of the city of Tillamook to move the fence on the north side of the Court-house block to conform to the street line. It was so ordered.

In the matter of the petition of T. J. Harris, et al., for a county road. Petition was granted and said road ordered opened.

In the matter of the petition of Wm. Schollmeyer, et al., for a county road. Wm. Finley, Everett Bales and H. V. Alley were appointed viewers, and A. M. Austin, surveyor, to meet at the store of Henry Fohl, on Wednesday, March 19th, at 9 o'clock a. m., or on their failure to meet on said day, within five days thereafter to view, survey and lay out said road as petitioned for and make a report of their proceedings hereunder to this court at its next regular term.

In the matter of the petition of C. H. Wheeler, et al., for the appointment of P. D. Newell as justice of the peace for the first justice district, to fill vacancy caused by vacancy caused by resignation of Wm. Batterson. It was so ordered.
