Tillamook City's Filipino Junta.

The British Tax no Food.

Sir Michael Hicks-Beach, chancellor of the British exchequer, evidently had not conferred with the merchants of the United Kingdom when he asserted that the imposition of duties on flour and grain would not increase the price of food. Wheat and flour have advanced materially since the announcement of the government's new policy for raising revenue and a further increase in the price of breadstuffs would not be surprising. It is rather remarkable that so capable and experienced a finance minister as Hicks Beach should have certainly thought a tax on food would not increase the price, for he certainly ought to have understood that British merchants would protect themselves by making the consumer pay the tax. Their course is perfectly natural and as the United Kingdom imports the greater part of its breadstuffs they may be able to maintain the advanced price. What effect the increased cost of food will have upon the mass of British consumers remains to be seen, but it is hardly to be supposed that there will be no popular complaint, for to millions of the people of the United Kingdom even a slight increase in the cost of food is a serious matter. The working classes are not as a whole prosperous and industrial conditions there for the last two or three years have not been favorable. To very many of the people a slight addition to the cost of living may mean privation, since they are already compelled to practice the closest economy. It is to be expected, therefore, that there will be a more or less vigorous outcry against the result of the food tax but it will, of course, be useless, since the government must have more revenue and this is the simplest way of obtaining it. No doubt the chancellor of the exchequer would have been glad to have found some other practicable and less unsatisfactory way of providing for the heavy demands upon the national treasury. The British tax upon breadstuffs is a matter of some interest to this country, which furnishes most of the flour and wheat consumed in the United Kingdom. Our exports of wheat to that country for the year ended June 30, 1901, amounted to over 78,000,000 bushels, besides which we exported nearly 11,000,000 barrels of flour. We also sent to the United Kingdom about 80,000,000 bushels of corn. The new budget imposes six cents per hundred weight on wheat and corn and ten cents per hundred weight on flour. STATE CAN SELECT LAND.

Hitchcock Gives Approval In Tillamook Case - Investigation Ordered to Determine Whether Fraud Has Been Committed.

OREGON CITY, May 1.—A letter was received at the Land Office today from Commissioner Hermann, of the General Land Office, enclosing a letter from the Secretary of the Interior bearing upon the application of the State of Oregon to select, as indemnity school land, 160 acres in Tillamook County that is involved in one of the Hays contest cases. The case is that of Hays vs. Eugene Jenkins. Last March a State selection was filed in the local land office, and that selection was enclosed a relinquishment from Eugene Jenkins, the entryman, and also a dismissal of the Hays contest and of the contest of G. O. Nolan against the entryman, Register Moores and Receiver Galloway disapproved as to whether the selection should be approved and because of such disagreement the matter was referred by the register to the Commissioner of the General Land Office for instructions. The register, in transmitting the withdrawals and relinquishments to the commissioner, stated that the circumstances warranted the belief that the purpose was to take the same action in all of the described cases, thus consummating, as he believed, the original fraud upon the Government initiated by Thayer and his associates, for whose ultimate benefit it is believed that the State selections had been preferred. Commissioner Hermann in turn submitted the matter to the Secretary of the Interior and, in the conclusion of his letter to the Secretary, said: "That after so long a time and expense of prosecution of the various hearings, and before final action can be had, all of the opposing parties should thus suddenly and voluntarily surrender all interest and allow the State to reap the advantage, is hardly compatible with the idea that entries and contests were initiated in good faith, and owing to the large area of very valuable timber that is involved I feel justified in asking the instructions of the Department that I may give proper directions to the local officers, that all of said cases may be correct hauled in their incipency." The Secretary, in a type-written letter of six pages, approves the selection and sets forth, among other things, that one of the objects of the investigation that has been ordered is to get evidence of the speculative character of these applications or entries, and so prevent the parties to the fraud from obtaining thereby a title to these lands, and as that object has already been accomplished in the Jenkins case by his relinquishment, it would seem that there is no longer a necessity to prosecute the investigation for that purpose in his case, or in any other to which relinquishments may be filed. The letter says further: "Through the original applications or entries were made for a fraudulent purpose, they being relinquished and as a consequence the fraudulent purpose there under abandoned and rendered impossible of consummation, no good reason is seen why the State, if it is furnished proper bases therefore, may not select said land as indemnity under its school grant. "You are instructed to cause an investigation to be prosecuted with the utmost promptness and vigor to the end that the parties to the frauds principally concerned in this transaction, if shown to have acted as alleged, may be promptly prosecuted in the courts and punished as their misdeeds require; for it is not necessary that they should have successfully accomplished their fraudulent scheme to make them amenable to the criminal law. "It is a rule of the State to select land only when there is a prospective purchaser, and the State in selecting acts rather as an agent of such purchaser than as a principal. It seems possible that the Secretary of the Interior is not advised that such is the rule and that the approval of such selection may be the means of successful accomplishment of the fraud charged, rather than a prevention of it.
