

Commissioners' Court.

The county court did not get through until Saturday, the remaining business transacted being as follows:

In the matter of the taxes of A. L. Alderman for the years 1894, 1896, 1899, 1900, 1901 and 1902, it was ordered that the county clerk issue redemption certificates to the State Land Board for all tax sales upon payment of full tax penalty.

In the matter of the contract of Clark & Buchanan, for auditing county books, the contract was approved.

The Headlight was awarded the contract to publish the delinquent tax list at 1 1/2c per line.
