The parties to the suit are the Pacific Railway & Navigation Company, known as the Lytle railroad plaintiff, vs. the Astoria & Columbia River Railroad Company, defendant. The cause of suit is the right of way between the mouth of the Willamette river to Garibaldi, a distance of about three miles over which both roads claim a right of way.
