

SAYS GOVERNOR HITS BIG INDUSTRY.

Dairy Commissioner Scores Chamberlain for Veto of Cheese Inspector Bill.

Governor Chamberlain has antagonized every man in Oregon whose livelihood depends on, or who is interested in, the dairy industry of the State...

This measure had the endorsement of every prominent dairyman in the State and would have assisted materially in increasing the quality and value of Oregon dairy products...

Other states have bills which provide for cheese and dairy inspectors as well as inspectors of animal foods, and one of the effects these laws have had is to improve the quality of dairy products to the extent that they can be sent right into our own territory and compete successfully with Oregon's products...

I venture to say that one inspector in Oregon could increase the value of the cheese output of the state at least 1 cent a pound, and this would make a difference every year of \$40,000, and it would cost the state \$1500 a year for the inspector's salary...

Up To The Assessor.

The House did its duty by passing the Beals bill to compel owners of timber land to furnish a cruise of their timber to the assessor, but the Senate, which appears to have been organized in the interest of the tax dodging capitalists and franchise grabbers, defeated the measure...

Now it is up to the assessor. He has had his salary raised to a decent figure, and he can very easily demonstrate to the people that he deserved the raise by compelling the timber owners to pay something like a just tax upon their holdings...
