






\$13,000 HELD UP!

On Account of the Bank Holiday Proclamations.

The Board of County Commissioners, which met last month, but was unable to transact business on account of the bank holidays, acted upon and allowed the following bills, and as the court will meet on Monday next, it was the intention of the court to order warrants to pay these bills. As Governor Chamberlain gave out that the bank holidays would be continued until the 14th, he fooled everybody by not issuing the proclamations from Thursday to Saturday of last week. This caused a lapse and the county court stands adjourned. Under the circumstances, County Judge Goodspeed will have to call a special session, for which he will have to give ten days' notice, or allow the whole of the November business to go over to the January term. He may, however, when the court meets Monday, transact what business there is. The bills 'held up' amount to about \$13,000, are as follows:
