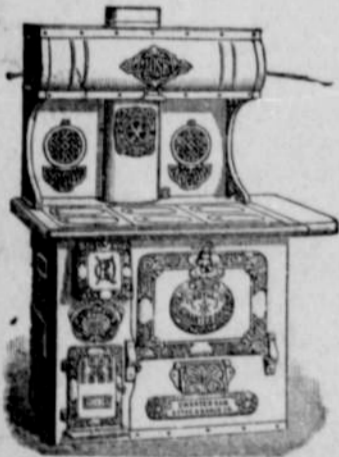
seal in sight, is of ever varying interest.
