**Commissioners' Court.**

The Board of County Commissioners, composed of County Judge H. F. Goodspeed and Commissioners Geo. W. Bodysfelt and H. V. Allen, met last week and transacted the following business:

In the matter of the approval of the additional platting and deed of dedication of Ocean Lake Park, the same were approved.

In the matter of the approval of the additional platting and deed of dedication of Rockaway Beach, the same were approved.

In the matter of the S. H. Rock road, the claim of E. J. and H. E. Mendenhall was rejected.

In the matter of bids for the construction of a bridge across Daugherty slough the bid of C. E. Dumbarton for \$650 and for \$700 as per specifications on file was rejected, and the bid of Walter D. Wood for \$625 was accepted.

It was ordered that a new No. 1 Elliott book typewriter, at a cost of \$185, be purchased for the Clerk's office, and that \$75 was to be allowed for the old machine.

In the matter of the Charles and Lizzie Johnson road, it was ordered that the Clerk notify Peter Jenck to remove the fence within five days, and if not removed then the supervisor would be ordered to do so.

In the matter of the bids for the construction of a bridge across Big Neatuc river, the bid of Walter D. Wood for \$1,250 and \$2.75 per foot for approach, and 30c. per yard for dirt and \$1 per yard for gravel fill, was rejected, and that of E. B. Cross for \$1,550 was accepted, which includes the approach and fill.

In the matter of the special election to be held on August 24, it appearing to the court that it was necessary to use the ballot boxes in Tillamook, Hoquarton, Fairview and South Prairie precincts, the Clerk was authorized to open them.
