TO FIGHT OLEOMARGARINE.

National Dairy Union Preparing to Defend Dairy Interests.

Our readers are familiar with the preliminary steps which were taken at the called meeting of the National Dairy Show in Milwaukee to reorganize the Union and place it in fighting shape to meet the coming assaults of the oleomargarine makers.

In accordance with such instruction, the directors, consisting of W. D. Hoard, of Wisconsin; S. B. Shilling and James Walker, of Illinois; Hon. Geo. L. Flanders, of New York; and Hon. James Foust, of Pennsylvania, met at the Raleigh House in Washington, D. C., Nov. 23rd, and completed the organization by electing Geo. L. Flanders, Albany, N. Y., as president; James Walker, of Chicago, vice president; and W. D. Hoard, treasurer.

The object in meeting at Washington was to obtain from the various officers of the government as clear a view as possible of the defects of the present Federal Oleomargarine law and what legislation is needed, if any, to remedy those defects and strengthen the law.

It is clearly evident that the coming session of congress, as well as future sessions, are going to be made the occasion of a determined assault upon the law by the oleomargarine forces.

The enemies of makers and consumers of honest butter feel confident that they will be able to break down all the safeguards against the counterfeiting of this great food product.
