

COUNTY BUSINESS.

Large Amount of Money Paid for Road Work.

The Board of County Commissioners, composed of County Judge H. F. Goodspeed and Commissioners G. W. Bodyfelt and H. V. Alley, was in session last week and transacted the following business:

In the matter of bids for a bridge across Wilson river at the Keifer place, the bid of E. E. Cross, in the sum of \$2500 was accepted, the bridge to be completed by Oct. 1.

Claim of Miami Lumber Co. for \$105.40 was allowed in the sum of \$55.13, balance rejected.

Claim of W. S. Cone for \$62.00, allowed in the sum of \$5.70, balance rejected.

In the matter of the construction of a bridge across Kilchis river, the bid of the Columbia Bridge Co. was accepted, which was for \$1,650.00 for bridge and \$18.50 per lineal foot for sub-structure, and Otto Schrader to act as inspector.

In the matter of the petition of A. H. Malaney for the appointment of a board of road viewers to survey, view out and establish a road, F. J. Owens, Ed. Worthington and Otto Schrader were appointed to serve on the board.

In the matter of the petition of C. J. Blanchard for a county road, the board of viewers having failed to meet on the date specified by the court, the 8th August is another date set for the board to meet.

In the matter of the approval of High Land addition to Tillamook, the same was approved.

In the matter of the approval of Cone's subdivision, the same was approved.

In the matter of an agreement between Tillamook County and the P. R. & N. Co., it was agreed that the right to use, appropriate and occupy said highways and streets for a period of 50 years.

In the matter of an agreement between Tillamook County and the P. R. & N. Co. to use "C" and other streets in Bay City, this was agreed to.

Road report of Blanchard road for \$32 was continued.

In the matter of the opening of a county road from Sandlake to Woods, the road supervisor was authorized to examine the proposed road and report at the next session of the court.

In the matter of deeds from G. B. Lamb for certain roads, the same were accepted.

In the matter of cancelling county warrants, the county clerk was instructed to advertise all county warrants issued prior to July 1, 1903.

In the matter of a bridge across the North Nehalem river at a point near the line between Clatsop and Tillamook counties, the county clerk was authorized to advertise after the situation had been investigated and passed on by Commissioner Alley.

In the matter of the petition of C. A. Johnson and others for the removal of W. H. Hoskins as supervisor of road district No. 2, the same was dismissed, and it was ordered that the supervisors and their deputies shall only allow time to their men for actual work performed on the roads.

Petition of Eastern Investment Co. Ltd. for taxes to be refunded, was granted in the sum of \$16.70.
