

COUNTY AFFAIRS.

Large Amount of Money Paid for Road Work.

The Board of County Commissioners, composed of County Judge H. F. Goodspeed and Commissioners H. V. Alley and G. W. Bodyfelt, transacted the following business last week.

A. Arstall resigned as supervisor of R. D. No. 6, and the same was accepted.

In the matter of the C. L. Fox Lumber Co. and Bay City Land Co., for the vacation of portions of lots and certain streets and parts thereof in First Water Front addition to the town of Bay City, the same was granted.

Claim of F. D. Turk for \$100 damages was rejected.

In the matter of the incorporation of Bay City, the court made an order duly incorporating that town, the votes being 46 for incorporation and 13 against, with T. L. Van De Wiele, mayor, Wm. Curtis, Alex Finlayson, Gust Nelson, J. T. Nevin, F. S. Shofield, and W. C. Trombley aldermen; J. J. Langcor marshal and D. W. Rhodes treasurer.

In the matter of a local option election for the county as a whole, the petition was granted and the election to take place on Tuesday, the 8th of November.

Claims continued were: St. Vincent's Hospital for \$20; Supervisor's report R. D. No. 5; Surveyor's report C. J. Blanchard road; claim of judges and clerks of election; and Beall & Co. for \$26.30.

In the matter of the petition of Helen S. Gray for the vacation of part of the plat of Short Sand Beach, the same was granted.

In the matter of the agreement between the Tillamook Electric Light and Fuel Co., the court granted the company the right to erect poles and string wire along the county roads, the franchise being for 30 years.

In the matter of bids on the Wm. Squires road the bid of L. L. Stillwell and W. H. Leach was rejected.

In the matter of the bid of Fred Burton on the Wm. Squires road, the same was accepted, as follows: For clearing right of way south of river, \$300; for clearing on north of river, \$300; making fill on south side 80 cents per cubic yard; making fill on north side, 60 cents per cubic yard.

In the matter of clerks and judges of election for Barnegat precinct, J. H. Biggs, Jr., A. C. Robeson and F. B. Mitchell were appointed clerks and Chris Olson, judge.

The court ordered three county warrants cancelled of small amounts.

In the matter of the S. Barber road, the same was ordered opened.
