## TAX AMENDMENT IS CARRIED BY 1655.

Counties Empowered to Choose Method.

## A SWEEPING CHANGE.

Legislature Deprived of All Power of Regulation -- Entering Wedge is Driven for Single Tax.

Compilation of the official vote on the various initiative and referendum measures, as canvassed by the county election boards, reverses the result heretofore announced on the county taxation amendment that appeared under the ballot numbers 326 Yes and 327 No. Instead of having been defeated, the complete figures show that the measure has carried by a majority of 1655.

The principal change made by official returns was in the vote in Multnomah County on this measure. The unofficial but complete tabnlations made several days ago indicated that the bill had received an adverse majority of nearly 1000 votes in Multnomah County. The official figures show that it carried in Multnomah by approximately 2000.

Radical Change Made.

The amendment carried is the most radical and sweeping of three tax amendments submitted. Two that were proposed by the Legislative Assembly in response to a movement fostered by the State Grange were defeated. These amendments removed the restric tions in the Constitution on exempting certain classes of property or on levying a less rate of taxation on one class of property than on anoth-

The county tax measure, as it is commonly known, was submitted through the initiative by the labor organizations of the State. It takes from the Legislature all power to pass laws regulating taxation or exemptions and gives that power solely to the people, although the Legislature may submit such laws for approval or rejection at the polls. Each county is permitted to regulate taxation within its borders as it sees fit. The levving of poll tax is prohibited.

The bill is regarded as having been designed as an entering wedge for "single tax" measures. Under its provisions a county whose voters were so disposed might adopt that could not muster strength in the state at large to be made a state
