John Larsen Dies Suddenly at Nehalem.

Surrounded by members of his family at his death bed John Larsen passed away Tuesday evening at nine o'clock from paralysis of the heart. He had eaten a hearty supper and did his usual amount of work that evening. He had neglected to attend to one errand however, and when he returned the other members of the family had gone to bed.

Soon afterwards he suffered from severe pains in the region of his heart and called for assistance. When they realized the serious condition of the stricken victim, they immediately telephoned for Dr. Randle who arrived ten minutes after the call was sent in. But Mr. Larsen was breathing his last when he reached the house and could do nothing to give relief. In a few moments all signs of life had vanished and the spirit had departed in peace to the other shore.

Mr. Larsen was one of the early settlers in this valley and enjoyed the respect and confidence of all who knew him as a man of unquestionable character and a devoted husband and father. He was of Danish birth and first saw the light of day September 26th, 1840, in the city of Dypel. In 1864 he fought in the war between Germany and Denmark and came to this country with Mrs. Larsen in 1869 to avoid service in the German army in the war of 1870 against France. They lived in Chicago two years before moving to Joplin City, Kansas. From thence they migrated to Lincoln County, Kan., where he fought Cherokee Indians in the early 70's. After several years of continuous residence in Lincoln County, the family moved to Oregon and settled on the North Fork of the Nehalem in 1891, after which they moved to Upper Town where they have lived since.

Through all these years he has under gone many hardships in providing for the needs of his household, having raised a family of nine children, two of whom have preceded him on their last journey. He has been hale and hearty all his days and never has had occasion to complain up to the last moment, when death called him.

He leaves a widow and seven children to mourn his loss. They are: Mrs. Clark and Hans Larsen, of Seaside; Chris Larsen, of Astoria; Thorvald V. Larsen, of Portland; and Rudolph, Sophus and Marina Larsen, of Nehalem.—Nehalem Enterprise.

Neither prayer or singing was associated with the preaching of the kingdom of God, nor was there any religious rites or ceremonies.

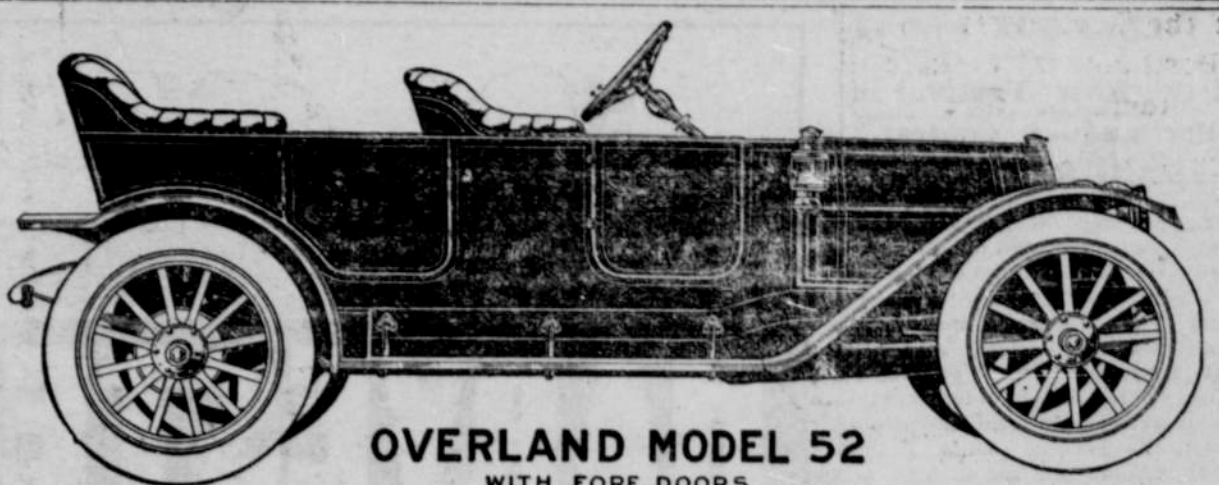
THE SAMENESS.
