

COUNTY AFFAIRS.

Here the Taxpayers' Money Goes.

The Board of County Commissioners, composed of Judge Mason and Commissioners Farmer and Wray, transacted the following business last week:

The claims of Glass & Prudhomme for \$24.18; P. F. Frazer for \$10 and Simmons & Goldsworthy \$26.95 were continued.

The bid of A. J. Burdick for wood for the court house, being the lowest at \$3.05 per cord for hemlock, was awarded the contract, and other bids rejected.

In the matter of the petition of At. Moroney for the vacating of the plats of the town of Moroney, the same was allowed.

In the matter of the petition of A. Eggs for a county road upon the report of the road viewers, it was ordered the same be a declared a public highway.

In the matter of the sale of lands in by Tillamook County for taxes, it was ordered that on Monday, July 1st, 1912, after having been given notice thereof in the manner provided by law, the sheriff shall offer for sale to the highest bidder for cash all lands heretofore in by the county; no land to be sold for less than the amount for which tracts were bid in by the county, which shall be the upset price.

In the matter of the petition of H. Follett for a county road, the same was continued.

In the matter of the petition to vacate part of the town of Wheeler, the same was dismissed.

In the matter of the claim of J. V. Tohl for damages, the same was allowed.

In the matter of the application of F. A. Smith for liquor license, the same was dismissed.

In the matter of the application of A. C. Vogler for liquor license the same was continued.

In the matter of the petition of C. R. Funk for a county road it was ordered that U. G. Jackson, Chas. Wells and W. B. Alderman be appointed a board of road viewers, to meet on the 15th May.

In the matter of the petition of Sam Bauer for a county road, upon the report of the board of viewers, the petition was granted and the same was declared a public highway.

In the matter of the petition of Fred F. Scherzinger to vacate road, the same was granted and the road ordered vacated.

In the matter of the petition of Grant Dawson for a county road, this was continued for further hearing.

In the matter of the approval of the plat and deed of dedication of the town of Seaport, the same was approved.

In the matter of the application of Edward Hadley for liquor license for Garibaldi precinct, the same was granted.
