

COMMISSIONERS' COURT.
Special Election to Enlarge
Bay City Port on Aug. 31.

The July term of the County Court was held last week, with a full board present, when the following business was transacted:

In the matter of the approval of the plat and deed of dedication of the town of Moroney, the same was approved.

In the matter of the amended plat of Tillamook Beach, it was ordered that the plat and deed of dedication be approved.

In the matter of the petition of W. Brobst and others for a county road, upon the report of the road viewers, the same was continued.

Claim of A. Zuercher for \$32.35 for travel was continued.

Claim of Mrs. E. D. Hoag for \$100 for care and board of Ella Saulding, was rejected.

Claim of Wm. Ilingsworth for work on Wilson river road, was continued.

In the matter of the application of the T. B. Potter Realty Co. for a liquor license, the same was granted for Barnegat precinct.

In the matter of the petition of Ant Dawson for a county road, the appeal of D. J. Dunn having been dismissed by request, the road is ordered opened.

In the matter of a petition for changing the boundaries of the port of Bay City and annexing new territory thereto, on a petition containing more than eight percent of the legal voters of the Port Bay City, it was ordered that a special election be called to embrace the land specified in the petition, the election to take place the 31st August.

In the matter of changing the boundaries of Nehalem and Foley voting precincts which places a part Nehalem precinct into Foley, was voted in the petition of Geo. R. Kimens and others.

In the matter of the deed of H. T. Hobesing and others for a county road, the same was continued.

In the matter of the petition of H. Brobst and others for a county road, the viewers' report accepted and road ordered to open.
