It is understood that the new owners of the timber tract have conferred with officials of the United Railways with reference to building the extension, but pend. ing the harbor development definite steps for carrying on the rail

road work will not be attempted. J. J. Hill and other officials of the Hill system frequently have asserted that the Tillamook bay line will be completed as soon as the ment and the Tillamook harbor is held out that harbor development alone is needed to make the rail extension certain.

It is probable that some of the timber will be cut and maketed even before the work at Tillamook is finished. In that event the logs will be brought to Portland and milled here. Construction of a connecting link from the Harriman line over the single mile separating it from the property is entirely feasible. This will be done if immediate development is desired.




