Standpat Democrats.

In the Senate Democratic party caucus, the free wool and free sugar schedules, as prepared by the Democratic House, under presidential direction, were left as certified to the Senate from the Democrats of the House, and as certified to the Democrats of the House from the Democrat in the White House. The president has made good what came dangerously near being his boast that he would "consider no compromises." At that time there was something which looked like open revolt among Democratic senators against both free wool and free sugar. And the Democratic majority in the Senate is so narrow that three or four Democratic votes against the White House measure could defeat it, since it progresses much too far in the direction of free trade to be supported by any of the small group of Progressive Republicans in that body. The president met the emergency in two ways. First, he made bold announcement of the fact that he would consider no compromise and listen to no talk of compromises. Second, he set afloat the stories of "insidious lobby influences" working against the measure, and forced the investigation of the charges, which he must have known to be practically baseless, with a view to starting popular fires behind senators believed to be wavering. The investigation is not yet over, but it is over for all of the president's uses, unless he may want to prolong it for forcing through his currency bill. It has been a complete water haul, on tariff lines, but perhaps it has frightened into submission some Democratic senators who otherwise would have stood out.

Fourth Class Postmasters Examination.

Saturday, August 9, 1913.

The United States Civil Service Commission announces that on the date named above an examination will be held at Tillamook, Ore., as a result of which it is expected to make certification to fill a contemplated vacancy in the position of fourth-class postmaster of class at Bayocean, and other vacancies as they may occur at that office, unless it shall be decided in the interests of the service to fill the vacancy by reinstatement. The compensation of the postmaster at this office was \$337.00 for the last fiscal year.

Age limit, 21 years and over on the date of the examination, with the exception that in a State where women are declared by statute to be of full age for all purposes at 18 years, women 18 years of age on the date of the examination will be admitted.

Applicants must reside within the territory supplied by the post office for which the examination is announced.

The examination is open to all citizens of the United States who can comply with the requirements.

Application forms and full information concerning the requirements of the examination can be secured from the postmaster at Bayocean, or from the U.S. Civil Service Commission, Washington, D.C.

Application should be properly executed and filed with the Commission at Washington at least 7 days before the date of the examination, otherwise it may be impracticable to examine the applicants.

Notice Closing Streams.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WHEREAS, the State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners, of the State of Oregon (as well as its predecessors, the Board of Fish Commissioners of the State of Oregon) has propagated and stocked, and is propagating and stocking the waters of Tillamook Bay and its tributaries, in Tillamook County, State of Oregon, with salmon fish, and WHEREAS, said Tillamook Bay and its tributaries are frequented by salmon fish, and, for the purpose of protecting the same, the said State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners have decided to close a tributary of said Tillamook Bay, known as the Hoquarton Slough, and its tributaries above a point on said Hoquarton Slough, 47 deg. 31 minutes West 2,013.7 feet from the section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, of Township 1 South, Range 10 West, of the Willamette Meridian—this point on said Hoquarton Slough being more particularly designated by posts erected by the Master Fish Warden warning the public; and also an other tributary of said Tillamook Bay, known as Miami River, above a point where the county wagon bridge crosses said Miami River just below the Pacific Railway & Navigation Company's railroad bridge crossing said Miami River, all being in Tillamook County, State of Oregon, to prevent fishing therein by any means whatever, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, for salmon fish, during the periods of time hereafter specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners that said tributary of Tillamook Bay, known as Hoquarton Slough, and its tributaries above a point on said Hoquarton Slough 47 deg. 31 minutes West 2,013.7 feet from the section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, of Township 1 South, Range 10 West, of the Willamette Meridian—this point on more particularly designated by posts erected by the Master Fish Warden warning the public, are and each of them is hereby closed to fishing of any kind for salmon fish, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, from and after July 17, 1913, until on and after October 15, 1913; and that the tributary of said Tillamook Bay, known as Miami River, above a point where the county wagon bridge crosses said Miami River just below the Pacific Railway & Navigation Company's railroad bridge crossing said Miami River, is hereby closed to fishing of any kind for salmon fish, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, from and after July 17th, 1913, until said tributary is opened again to salmon fishing, as provided for under Sec-

tion 5316 of Lord's Oregon Laws, and it is and will be unlawful to fish for, or take, or catch any salmon fish by any means whatever, except with hook and line, commonly called angling, in any of said waters during the said periods of time above specified.

Any and all persons whomsoever so fishing in violation of this notice will be prosecuted as by law provided.
