### An Adequate Navy.

The leading armed powers of Europe are well disposed toward the United States and show no active opposition to the Monroe doctrine asserting that the United States has rightfully a paramount interest in the preservation of American territory from foreign aggression, and the freedom of American governments from foreign dictation. But the Monroe principle implies power to act as well as a disposition to draw a line on what shall and shall not be in America. Recognized international law applies to America as well as other continents. The position of Monroe was not taken to encourage turbulent or irresponsible methods of government in the New World. Conditions may become so bad in some countries that all other powers will have a grievance. At times it has been so in China, and several nations have combined to enforce general international law. Some on occasion have also acted separately. It is not the province of the Monroe doctrine to declare that these forms of intervention shall cease. But as far as America is concerned this country claims the initiative steps.

A Monroe doctrine without an effective navy would be only an abstraction. But the people of the United States hold it to be alive and for practical use. Then what is an adequate navy? Admiral Dewey defines it as a fleet second only to that of Great Britain. At present the second place in naval strength is disputed, which is equivalent to the admission that our naval rank is in doubt. In the present Congress it has been hard to gain consent to the construction of even one first-class battle ship. Yet it is unlikely that a single member would vote for the abandonment of the Monroe doctrine. "Hands off of American territory" is a wise rule, but it does not follow that unbounded licence is to be allowed an American country continually in a state of rebellious tumult, unable to conduct itself peaceably or to protect foreigners who have been invited to come, and then find themselves threatened in life and property by endless revolts of an anarchical type. No navy can be adequate for this country unless it is prepared at any time to back up the Monroe doctrine.
