Rockaway Gets New Church.

Arrangements are being made to erect a church building to cost about \$400 on a lot which will be donated by the Rockaway Beach Company at that place. The Presbytery of Portland will take up the matter of constructing the building and will be responsible for the property till such a time as a permanent church is organized there. The Rockaway Sunday school is well attended, the Bible class having 53 and the children's class 14 in attendance last Sunday evening.
