2.24 A CAMPAIGN OF ODDITIES.

2.24 When the Log Cabin and Hard Cider Enthusiasts Rejoiced. Political enthusiasm has taken many

forms during the lifetime of this na-5.63 tion. The Harrison-Van Buren presidential campaign of 1840 was in some respects the most remarkable the coun-5.00 try has ever seen. "From May till No vember," says one historian, "it seemed as if all ablebodied citizens simply went about in processions to attend 3.13 mass meetings."

The great oddity of the campaign 1.88 was the log cabin, the coon and the clder barrel. The log cabin idea originated with an opposition paper which had said slightingly that "William Henry Harrison better go back to Indiana and stay there in his log cabin 6.80 drinking bard cider."

The taunt was taken up by Harrison's followers. Log cabins sprang up 1.25 all over the Union. In every town there was a house warming, and the log cabin was thrown open to the public amid general rejoicing. If it is a narrow vane, for instance, the weight of the solid head is easily made equal to that of the longer, projecting but thinner feather end, and all vanes, whatever they may be, are balanced as to weight and so adjusted that they turn easily and with the least possible friction.
