Prayers for Rain.

"When things get to the worst they begin to mend," perhaps for the reason that not until the worst is reached do men abandon all confidence in themselves and begin to pray. All Kansas, and other parts of the drought stricken section, are turning to prayer for rain now. There is public proclamation of days of prayer. Nobody will doubt the earnestness of the praying. The land is blighted with a dry desolation. Suffering is intense, and threatening to grow greater. Men have seen their valuable property shrivel into insignificance under the glare of a sun shining down after dark, in a cloudless sky. They have had to part with herds, either through death by water famine or forced sale to avoid it, the loss of which, in either way, means loss of wealth. Not until disease, springing out of such prolonged evil conditions threaten them and their families, do they prostrate themselves with one accord before that supreme power which holds worlds in the hollow of a hand.

And because this prayer wave, welling up in a mighty flood from broken and contrite hearts, will surge high and long, and have in it that hope and trust in an unseen power which is so nearly akin to faith, who shall call in vain? Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen," wrote that greatest intellect whose analysis of faith, and the mode of its operation, must convince even the most worldly mind, capable of grasping its deep meaning, of power of the human spirit, divested of pride and all selfishness, and no longer seeking to declare its own ways against the better purposes of God, to move nature itself. This is plainly one of the things seen by the master seer and interpreter who wrote: "There are more things in heaven and earth, Horatio, than are dreamt of in your philosophy."

Prayer, in great extremity, is as instinctive to man as is the instinct of self preservation, nature's first law. Prayer is, in fact, or so it often becomes under such affliction and danger as now beset the wasted lands, a part of the instinct of self-preservation, and therefore a part of nature's first law. He who scoffs in hours of ease and safety goes down on his narrow bones in times of peril or adversity. That character in the "Pike County Ballads"

who admits that he "don't go much on religion" because he "ain't never had no show," nevertheless tells us that when he realized his own helplessness he dropped "crotch deep in the snow and prayed." He is rather pusillanimous in saying, after his prayer was answered, that he thinks the angels ought to be better employed in doing such thankless work than in "loafin'" around a throne." But what a glorious foil to such a sorry character as his, was the great Confederate captain who never lost a battle, perhaps because the prelude to every one of them was a short, hurried prayer, which is best described by one of his own men in the line.

Lay bare thine arm! Stretch forth thy rod! Amen! That's Stonewall's way. It has been the way of many other great soldiers. It is the way of strong men, who alone can realize human weakness at its strongest. It is the way of strong men now, who in despair of their own strength, are to cry out, as in one voice, for help from that source of all strength to which, in times of peril and helplessness, mankind turns, if only until it is saved, in that faith which can sometimes move mountains.
