At noon I found my latitude. After working out both, found my position 45:38 north, longitude 134:26 west.

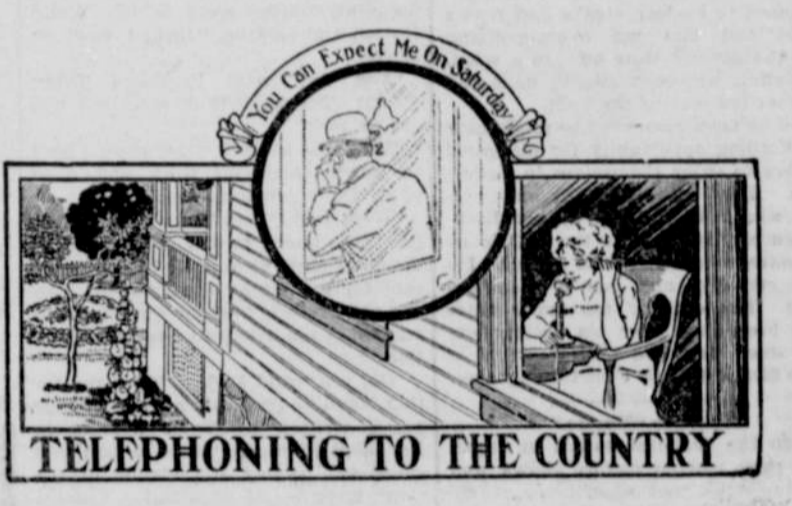
