**Water Permits.**

Forest J. Ayer of Beaver, has secured a permit to appropriate water from an unnamed spring in Sec. 30, Tp. 38, R. 9 W. for domestic purposes. Geo. Cohn of Tillamook, secured a permit for the irrigation of 140 acres of land, including domestic purposes, the water being diverted in Sec. 31, Tp. 1 S, low from Fall Creek. D. S. Davidson of Beaver, secured a permit for domestic purposes, diverting the water from Davidson spring in Sec. 32, Tp. 3 S, R. 9 W. C. J. Schnabel of Portland, secured a permit for manufacturing purposes, diverting the water from Cannery Creek in Sec. 21 Tp. 1 N, R. 10 W. The Wheeler Lumber Company of Tillamook, secured a permit for manufacturing and domestic purposes; the water being diverted from an unnamed creek in Sec. 10, Tp. N., R. 10 W. H. S. Davidson and R. O. Richards of Beaver secured a permit for the development of 34 horsepower, including domestic purposes; the water being diverted in from Folland Creek in Sec. 33, Tp. 3 S, R. 9 W.

South America begins to realize that the Panama Canal will open a new commercial era and also direct the world's attention more distinctly to the group of Latin-American republics. All are in an early stage of development and have a future of large opportunities. None are worn-out countries. Their primitive resources are still available to make or mar. As an example of the magnitude of these natural advantages take the place of Brazil. The area of Brazil is greater than that of the forty-eight states of the American Union. It is twice that of India with its hundreds of millions of inhabitants, and fifteen times that of France. Nearly all of Brazil could be utilized by settlers. The eastern part is suitable for cultivation or pasturage and has valuable mines. To the west a vast level region is drained by the Amazon, but as yet it has few except aboriginal inhabitants. There are no deserts such as are found in several South American states, yet the present population is confined to the coast strip and neighboring valleys, and a few inland districts like those in which \$200,000,000 worth of coffee is raised annually. A broad tropical region adjoins long reaches that are subtropical, and then temperate, a country to produce sugar, coffee, cattle, cotton, rubber and fine timber on an immense scale.
