Favors Concrete With Crushed Rock Bids to be Re-Advertised. In the matter of the petition of J. B. Lommen and others for a county road, R. L. Shreve, F. E. Hobson and Alex McDonald were appointed road viewers.

Bids for Hard Surfacing. In the matter of bids for the improvement of Fairview road, Tillamook-Bay City road and Hunt's bridge road, the bids were as follows:

County Commissioners to Consider Road Types. The County Commissioners met with Roadmaster Yeon, Road Engineer Nunn and District Attorney Evans in an executive session.

Another executive session will be held today to consider the recommendations of Roadmaster Yeon as to the type or types of pavement to be laid on each of the 27 road units to be hard surfaced and the awarding of the contracts.

It is well understood, though not announced to this effect was made after yesterday's meeting, that Mr. Yeon has recommended the specifications as bitulithic for the Columbia River Highway and the various county roads, except on the Canyon road, which has a grade of 7 1/2 per cent.

The man who undertakes to break or train a colt must be of a gentle kind, perserving nature. He must avoid fright and harshness. It must be remembered that the horse, like all dumb animals, can only be made to understand language by accompanying action with words, that is, some action must be associated with the command. For example, on coming to the animal while yet in the stall, we want to teach him to step aside, so we may be able to get up to his head, we say "step over," and at the same time lay our hand on his hip on the side from which it is to move, and increase the weight of the hand to a push, until the colt steps over.
