

Dougall concluded at the members' council of the Chamber of Commerce in Portland Monday the duel they had begun the week be-fore over the term the due Monday the duel they had begun the week be-fore over the statement made by Mr. Dougall that the lumber interests had been treated unfairly by the county in letting of contracts for road paving. Chairman E. L. Thompson inform-ed the speakers at the outset that personalities were not to be indulged in and then "turned them loose." "I am not going to discuss Mr. Holman as a friend of mine, but as a politician," was Dougall's preface to his speech.

"I will not refer to Mr. Dougall, who is a life long and bosom friend of mine, personally," retorted Mr. Hol-man when he began to speak, "but as a lobbyist for certain timber interests Mr. Dougall reiterated has assertions of the previous week that the County Commissioners had discrim-inated against the advocates of wood block paving, and called attention to the fact that Mr. Holman himself had introduced a resolution to the Chamber urging that the county be requested to give a 5 per cent prefer-ential on Oregon made products in letting contracts. "Later facts have shown that you might just as well thrown that resolution into the river,"

He declared that on the St. Johns ferry they had installed a sys-tem of oil burning which cost \$6.87 a day, whereas when they were burning slabwood and sawmill waste, it cost only \$6.41 per day. 
