The Road Supervisor Problem. Some of the counties are going through the same experience with road supervisors as Tillamook County had some years ago, and they are gradually following the example of this county in dispensing with them.

"Farmers' teams are not suitable for road work, neither is the farmer. A man can not be both a good farmer and a good road builder, one or the other occupations will be neglected at the expense of the other."

"Out of the 33 supervisors of Coos County it is safe to say that 27 of them know no more about practical road work than they do about building a war ship, and we get this system by the law that requires that the county court shall appoint some person who resides in the district as road builder at \$2.50 per day."

"I believe that one half of the money now expended could be saved, or at least bring double the amount of road improvement for the money that we are now expending."

Hot Milk vs. Whiskey. (From the Rural Spirit.) The first day of January the three states of Oregon, Washington and Idaho will go dry and, while it will still be possible to secure some whiskey, the open saloon will be a thing of the past.

It is a well established fact that hot milk is a better stimulant, in case of extreme exhaustion or chill than is whiskey or any other intoxicant. And the Rural Spirit believes that at this time, while cold weather is on, an organized and concerted effort should be made to extend its use.

The Rural Spirit of November 21st contained a little item to the effect that the National Dairy Council had set aside \$250,000 to be used in a propaganda for the larger use of milk.

Of course hot milk, like cold milk, needs care. Warnings should be given that the milk must not be boiled, but merely kept hot and that vessels holding the milk must at regular intervals be carefully cleaned with tepid water and then scalded.

LIQUOR AFFIDAVITS FILLED WITH TEETH. Law Provides Four Kinds of Blanks To Cover All Cases.

Here they are. These are the affidavits you will have to sign to get liquor for any purpose whatever after January 1. The affidavits will be filed with the County Clerk and kept on record for your neighbors to look at for two years.

1. The kind the actual consumer will have to sign to get his 24 quarts of beer once in four weeks.

2. The kind ministers and officers of fraternal organizations will fill out to get liquor for sacramental purposes.

3. The kind pharmacists will use when filling prescriptions of alcohol for medical purposes.

4. The kind pharmacists will have to use for the sale of ethyl alcohol for pharmaceutical, scientific and mechanical purpose and for external use.

Let's take them up one at a time. Notice the affidavit in class one. One must swear that in the last four weeks he has not received from a common carrier such a quantity of liquor as will, with that received on the day of the affidavit, make more than the statutory limit.

Notice that in affidavit No. 3 you have to swear that the liquor you buy is for a medical purpose and that you have to swear what that purpose is. Then you must take your oath that the liquor will be used for no other purpose, and that you will not sell it or give it away.

On each form of affidavit you will find this caution: "False swearing in the preparation of the foregoing affidavit subjects the person guilty thereof to punishment by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not less than two or more than five years."

36 "QUART" BOTTLES ALLOWED MONTHLY? Arithmetic and Law Seem to Bear Out Dopesters' Claims.

Dopesters have figured a way in which they believe they can stretch the statutory 24 quarts of beer one may legally import in any four weeks after the first of the year into 36 "quart" bottles of brew.

The well-known authority on words and their meaning says a quart is one fourth of a gallon. A gallon of water weighs a trifle more than eight pounds. Therefore a quart would weigh two pounds or 32 ounces.

One standard quart equals 32 ounces. Thirty-two times 24 divided by 21 equals 36.47.

Therefore you can get 36 bottles of beer, within the law. Q. E. D.

Here it is the other way, which makes it appear that you may import 30 bottles of beer every four weeks. The breweries bill five large bottles of beer to the gallon.

"The law says 24 quarts all right," said District Attorney Evans this morning. "I guess the breweries will have to start putting out beer in full quart bottles to avoid complication."
