CIRCUIT COURT. Court Adjourn and Will Meet Again In November.

The October term of the Circuit Court was adjourned on Saturday evening, after being in session for two weeks. Judge Geo. R. Bagley will hold an adjourned term on the 20th of November when he expects to dispose of most of the cases now on the docket.

State of Oregon vs. P. J. Worrall. Charged with violating the prohibition law, an appeal from justice court. Jury trial and verdict in favor of defendant.

Meier & Frank Co. vs. W. R. Rossman. Action for damages. Tried by jury and directed jury in favor of the plaintiff. Paul Kolstrup vs. A. G. Davidson and wife. Action for money. Default and decree.

There was a Republican meeting at the court house on Thursday, which was well filled to hear Attorney R. R. Duniway on behalf of Hughes and the Republican ticket.
